In school we will be learning to:

- Read and write more complex sentences.
- Use punctuation correctly.
- Read and spell sight words independently.

At home you can:

Segment and spell more complex words as well as the high frequency words we are learning in school.

Practise writing skills by encouraging children to help write shopping lists, to do lists, cards etc.

Communication and Language

In school we will be learning to:

- Talk about the plans they have made to carry out activities and what they might change if they were to repeat them.
- To respond to questions and make relevant comments about their own experiences.

At home you can:

Encourage children to talk through what they do and think and reflect upon their actions/choices. Would they change anything if they were to do it again?

In school / At home

Maths

In school we will be learning to:

- Add and subtract increasingly larger numbers using different strategies eg. fingers, objects, a number line, Numicon.
- Estimate a number of objects and check quantities by counting.
- Solve practical problems that involve combining groups of 2, 5 or 10, or sharing into equal groups.

At home you can:

Cover one number in a set and ask children to identify which one is hidden. Explain why you think that?

Encourage children to help with everyday tasks such as cooking — talk about different weights, sizes, amounts.

Understanding of the World

In school/At home:

- To use technology as a tool for learning.
- To make observations about different materials and make comments about purposes they are used for.

Expressive Art and Design

- Talk about the ideas and processes which have led to making music, designs, images or products.
